MISSING FROM MY COLLECTION

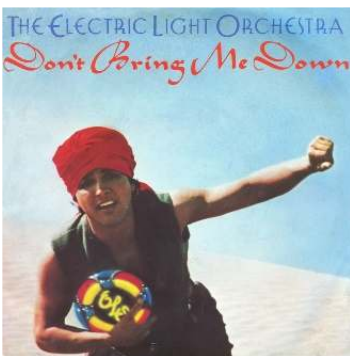
In July 2023 a clear vinyl pressing was found in a job lot of records bought on eBay. It does play Horace Wimp and Down Home Town.

 "Jeff Lynne CBS Songs Ltd...." is under "Buildings Have Eyes" song title.

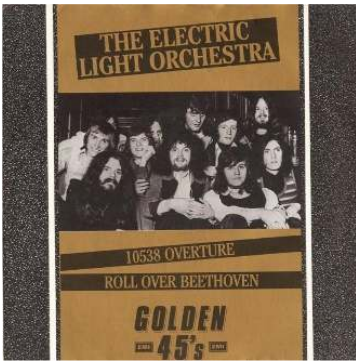

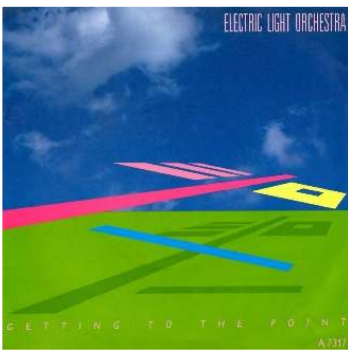
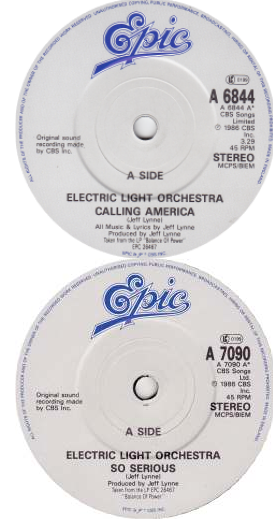

Notes:

Any large centre hole versions that are listed, were issued for Juke Boxes and general public sale.

ELO JB1 single. which was for Juke Box use, appeared in the UK Singles sales chart, hence why it is included.

The singles that were issued in picture sleeves, it is noted where possible which label versions were issued/are in which type of sleeve.

The singles with a 2nd different font/text layout version, may have originally come in picture sleeves or Jet Company sleeves or plain white sleeves.

Livin' Thing UP 36184 was issued in plain white or black sleeves, some issues may also have come in brown UA sleeves.

Rockaria! UP 36209 Later Issues, Telephone Line UP36254 First Issue & The Way Life's Meant To Be Jet 7021 may originally only have been issued in plain white sleeves.
